The UN Global Compact is embarking on a new era of engagement with its non-business stakeholders. To provide non-business participants with both an enhanced opportunity to engage more actively with the initiative and a more robust channel to connect with business participants, the Global Compact has introduced the COE. Upon joining, the Global Compact asks non-business participants to undertake one or more specific activities in support of the initiative (refer here to the [list of activities by type of non-business participant](#) – i.e. academia, business association, cities, NGOs, labour and public sector organization). The COE is a disclosure of these specific activities and their results.

Your organization will be required to submit a COE to the Global Compact website within two years of 31 October 2013, and every two years thereafter. Failure to submit a COE every two years will result in a change of your organization's participant status to "non-communicating". Organizations that do not submit a COE within one year of becoming "non-communicating" will be expelled from the initiative.

Launched today, the COE is a tool for non-business participants to express their commitment through transparency and communicate the ways they advance the Global Compact. In the spirit of continuous improvement and engagement, non-business participants will be required to disclose specific activities in support of the initiative to stakeholders every two years, as well as results.

Upon joining, the Global Compact asks non-business participants to undertake one or more specific activities in support of the initiative (refer here to the [list of activities by type of non-business participant](#) – i.e. academia, business association, cities, NGOs, labour and public sector organization). The COE is a disclosure of these specific activities and their results.

Your organization will be required to submit a COE to the Global Compact website within two years of 31 October 2013, and every two years thereafter. Failure to submit a COE every two years will result in a change of your organization's participant status to "non-communicating". Organizations that do not submit a COE within one year of becoming "non-communicating" will be expelled from the initiative.
